Through crossing with Hybrid teas, great improvements have been made in flower formation, while still retaining their vigour and freedom of blooming. They are superb border plants, giving wonderful colour and fragrance from October to June.

True pearly white blooms tinted with soft pink. Born in small clusters on a vigorous medium bush with dark green foliage. Very highly scented. 1.1m



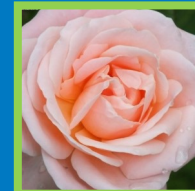
## Antique Affair

# hybrid tea bush roses

Hybrid teas traditionally produce the showiest blooms. Most roses at florist shops are hybrid tea varieties. Today's rose breeding emphasizes fragrance and vigour. The form of a hybrid tea rose is tall and upright, with sparse foliage toward the base. Blooms develop on long stems, and the buds are often as elegant as the open flowers.

Glorious blooms of apricot amber carried proudly on long sturdy stems, scented and perfect for picking. Growth is upright and bushy. 1.2m



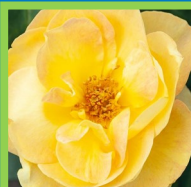
### Blackberry Nip

Luscious, heavy, fragrance oozes from every pore of this perfectly formed flower. Superb for picking. Healthy vigorous grower. 1m



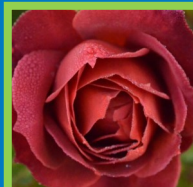
### Imagine

Deliciously fragrant, large silvery white flowers unfurl in a swirl of petals with subtle notched edges. A sport of the ever popular 'Memorial Day'. 1.2m



### Smokey Joe

Warm copper orange flowers with a smokey edge. Bronzy dark green glossy foliage, slightly fragrant. Named after the devices in WW2 that warned danger. 1m



### St Pauls Cathedral

Pointed buds opening creamy white, displayed to perfection above the deep green foliage-compact. Named after the Wellington Cathedral of St Paul, consecrated in 1852. 1m



### Super Trouper

What a knockout colour. High buds, plenty of flowers, on long stems. Excellent Award Winning rose. Bright Orange. 1.2m

# david austin roses

English Roses combine the form of the flower, the fragrance and general character of an Old Rose with a wide range of colour and the repeat flowering, of a modern Hybrid Tea or Floribunda Rose; they also retain much of the busy, shrubby growth of the old varieties. All David Austin roses have a collective style and reflect one man's vision. All have beautiful blooms and in most cases wonderful fragrance held on graceful attractive shrubs. A garden of these outstanding roses is hard to beat for sheer exuberance of flower and fragrance.

**Abraham Darby**

Abraham Darby bears large, deeply cupped blooms in shades of pink, apricot and yellow. They have a rich, fruity fragrance with a refreshing sharpness. 1.4m



**Darcey Bussell**

The colour is a deep, rich crimson-pink, taking on a tinge of mauve just before the petals drop. There is a light-medium fruity scent. It forms a compact shrub with attractive bushy growth.



**Graham Thomas**

Bears medium-sized, cupped blooms of an unusually rich, pure yellow. Light Tea fragrance, with a cool violet character. It forms a bushy, upright and vigorous shrub. 1.2m



**L D Braithwaite**

The brightest, crimson blooms of all the English Roses. Petals are loosely arranged to form beautiful, large, slightly cupped blooms that open wide and flat. 1.2m



**Pat Austin**

Bright copper on the inside of the petals, with pale copper-yellow on the outer sides. The flowers are large and deeply cupped. There is a strong tea scent. 1.6m



**The Lady Gardener**

Bears large, quartered rosettes, each about 4" across, packed with loosely arranged petals. They are a beautiful shade of pure apricot, paling towards the edges. Tea fragrance. 1.4m



**Wildeve**

Gorgeous classic rosette blooms of soft blush pink with hints of apricot. Freshly fragrant this strong healthy grower is great for mixed planting with blooms produced on arching branches.1.5m



**Boscobel**

Beautiful, salmon pink, upward-facing blooms, held on strong stems. They commence as red buds which open at first to pretty cups, gradually developing into rosettes. Myrrh fragrance. 1.8m



**Gertrude Jekyll**

Perfect scrolled buds open to large, rosette-shaped flowers of bright glowing pink. Perfectly balanced Old Rose scent. A vigorous rose; it will form a medium-sized shrub. 1.2m



**Heritage**

This is a flower of delicate shell-like beauty. The blooms are of perfectly cupped and of medium size. Fragrance of fruit, honey and carnation on a myrrh background.1.6m



**Munstead Wood**

Deep, velvety crimson blooms, with lighter coloured outer petals. There is a strong Old Rose fragrance with fruity notes of black berry, blueberry and damson. Young red leaves later turn green.



**Sharif Asma**

Its colour is the most delicate blush pink, paling almost to white at the outer edges. Strong fragrance, with fruity notes reminiscent of white grapes and mulberry. 1.2m



**Thomas A Becket**

Blooms have an Old Rose fragrance with a strong lemon zest character. Flowers are an attractive light red paling to carmine red. 1.6m



**William Shakespeare**

Exquisite, rich velvety crimson blooms, gradually changing to an equally rich purple. Features a strong, warm Old Rose fragrance. Neat, upright growth.



**Charlotte**

Bears exquisite flowers of a soft yellow colour. Each bloom is packed with numerous small petals, arranged around a classic button eye. There is a pleasant Tea fragrance.



**Golden Celebration**

One of the largest-flowered English Roses, bearing rich yellow blooms. Features a very strong Tea fragrance, developing wonderfully combined notes of Sauternes wine and strawberry.



**Lady of Shallot**

Rich orange-red buds open to blooms, filled with loosely arranged, orange petals. The outer petals are salmon-pink with beautifully contrasting golden-yellow undersides. Tea fragrance



**Olivia Rose**

Pretty buds open to beautiful mid pink colouring. They have a light to medium fruity fragrance. Named after the daughter of David Austin Junior and granddaughter of David Austin Senior.



**Summer Song**

Vibrant blooms of an unusual orange-red colour. There is a lovely mixed scent with hints of chrysanthemum leaves, ripe bananas and Tea. It forms a bushy, upright shrub. 1.3m



**Tranquillity**

The opening buds are lightly tinged with yellow but as the flowers open they become pure white. There is a light apple fragrance. Almost thornless. 1.6m



**Winchester Cathedral**

A white sport of 'Mary Rose', with the occasional touch of pink. It makes a well-shaped shrub with twiggy, bushy growth and nice foliage. Named after one of the finest cathedrals in Britain.

# climbing roses

Most climbing roses are mutations or variations of bush-type varieties. Climbers can be trained to bloom more heavily by leading their canes in a horizontal direction. Loose anchoring to a support will encourage young plants to climb. Climbing roses add a whole new heady dimension to the garden and allow us to enjoy our favourite blooms at nose or eye level.

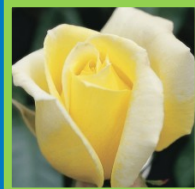
**Arrowtown**

Apricot buds opening to large well formed blooms of golden yellow. Lovely for cutting. Medium sized bush but vigorous.



**Birthday Present**

Deep velvety crimson, very fragrant, very vigorous grower.



**Casino**

Soft yellow, fragrant flowers that repeat well, accentuated on the dark and glossy foliage. A good climber.



**Compassion**

Salmon pink shaded apricot orange, fragrant and very vigorous strong grower. Award winner.



**Cupcake**

Pretty soft pink cup-shaped blooms with sweet fragrance. Masses of flowers repeat in a beautiful display. Bred by Bob Matthews.



**Fourth of July**

American Award Winner by Tom Carruth. Like fireworks on Independence day, masses of blooms are streaked with white and velvety red, foliage is sparkly green and the growth healthy.



**Golden Gate**

This multi-award winner is a stunner and one of the best. Large golden yellow fragrant flowers, that repeat well and cover the vigorous shapely plant.



**Iceberg**

Clusters of pure white blooms which keep flowering. Strong grower, disease resistant. One of the best.



**Newsflash**

Brighten up a space in your garden with this international award winning rose. The vibrant, clear orange blooms repeat flower in flushes on an extremely healthy, easy care plant. Fragrant.



**Sir Edmund Hillary**

Highly scented flowers of beautiful form open wide to a delightful blend of pure white with golden centres. Healthy, glossy foliage and strong growth.



**Top Brass**

A peach apricot bud opening slowly to amber. Has a dahlia-like appearance with petals curving back to the stem. Very vigorous and healthy.



**Uetersen**

Large clusters of bright pink frilly blooms with fragrance. Very free flowering, with glossy light green foliage. Moderate spreading habit ideal for a small area or pillar.



**Westerland**

Bronze to salmon-apricot. Free-flowering on vigorous plant of spreading habit.



**Alberic Barbier**

Clusters of double, creamy white flowers with a fruity fragrance. Almost evergreen, extremely disease free, with strong vigorous growth to 6-8m.



**Banksia The Pearl**

Tall growing vigorous, semi evergreen climber. Clusters of dainty small white flowers in spring. Thornless, quick growing.



**Banksia White**

Tall growing vigorous, semi evergreen climber. Clusters of dainty small white flowers in spring. Thornless, quick growing.



**Banksia Yellow**

Tall growing, vigorous, semi evergreen climber. Clusters of small double yellow flowers in spring. Thornless, quick growing.



**Crepuscle**

Medium apricot double flowers borne freely on the spreading growth. Repeat flowering. Suited to pergolas or ideal as a floral blanket on a fence.



**Gloire de Dijon**

Huge, quartered flat blooms of buff-yellow and hints of apricot. Grows to 6 meters. Extremely fragrant and likes a sheltered and warm position. Recurrent.



**Madam Alfred Carriere**

Large, white with salmon-pink tinted flowers freely produced on this lovely "Old Rose". Very fragrant. Vigorous growing, disease free and reliable. Recurrent.



**Zepherine Drouhin**

Silvery-pink, richly fragrant flowers produced in clusters. Vigorous climber with glossy foliage. Recurrent.
